## LASER CATARACT SURGERY

Many of the steps of cataract surgery that are traditionally performed using handheld instruments can now be completed using the precision of a laser. This enables your surgeon to create a tailored treatment plan that helps meet your goals for vision.

Your surgeon can create laser-precise incisions to reduce astigmatism as well as to create a circular opening in the lens capsule to access and remove the cataract. Using the laser system your surgeon can soften the hard cataract enabling the cataract to be gently removed.



# CATARACT SURGERY OPTIONS

## Basic Vision

Overall vision clarity improved  
Will need glasses to optimize vision

## Astigmatism Reduction

Maximizes distance vision  
Reading glasses needed for near vision

## Lifestyle Vision

The most independence from glasses  
with a fuller range of focus



### Traditional Cataract Surgery

Monofocal intraocular lens implant

Overall vision quality improved  
Will need glasses to optimize focus

### Astigmatism Reduction

Femtosecond laser +/- enhanced or toric intraocular lens implant

Improved distance vision without glasses

Most patients still need reading glasses

### Lifestyle Lens

Femtosecond laser +/- multifocal intraocular lens implant

Maximum glasses independence  
No glasses needed for the majority of daily activities

Glasses may still be needed for reading fine print or night driving
